Roles and Responsibilities of the Board of Representatives

3. Formulate and present ideas to the Youth Advisory Council from the ideas and proposals collected within their state. These ideas are to promote the spiritual growth and well being of youth across the country.
4. The Representatives are responsible for executing tasks or assignments given by the Youth Advisory Council leadership.
5. Be able to meet any financial obligations (attend the AIM Convention, supplies for reports, proposals, reports and offerings etc.)
6. Prepare reports, and communicate back to the youth advisory council on behalf of the Youth department leadership.
